“HAVE A BALL IN THE FALL”

Fall is that wonderful time of the year that showcases many wonderful memories. May-Lan Tree Plantation invites you to bring your students to our farm where they will make many new memories by participating in the wide range of available fun, learning activities.

Here's just a sample of the fun stuff you can do while you visit with us. As you take an old-fashioned hayride through the farm, **Broomhead** and **Pumpkinhead** people will help guide your wagon as they go about their chores. After the hayride, find your way through the *maze*, learn about bats at the *Bat Cave* learning station, carefully cross the swamp at *Alligator Alley*, crawl through *Bugsy* the 40' caterpillar, enjoy a visit with our *Barnyard Buddies*, and finally select your very own *sugar pumpkin* at our pumpkin patch.

Your kids will have fun and learn at the same time. Photo opportunities abound for your bulletin board, so don't forget the camera!!

This year we will have *Mulch Mountain* open for the very first time! *Mulch Mountain* is a MOUNTAIN of mulch (guess you kinda figured that one out) over 100 feet long, 30 feet wide, and kinda tall. Come on, have you ever tried to measure a mountain? Our Mountain comes with a bridge, tunnels, slides, and all the information in the world on mulch, so your kids will have fun and learn! We do require that adult supervision be provided by persons involved with children using the Mountain!

Our *picnic area* is available for your lunch break and is suited for letting the kids go wild and still be safe. *Port-o-lets* and *hand wash facilities* are close by.

This year, we are offering three different ways for your kids to enjoy a trip to the farm.

Our complete “Have A Ball In The Fall” is priced at only \$7.50 per person and includes all the above- and then some.

The next package includes the hayride, a visit with our Barnyard Buddies, and the opportunity for everyone to select their own pie pumpkin. This is priced at \$5.50 per person.

The third way to get out in the fresh air is to take the hayride only. This is priced at \$3.50 per person.

Regardless of the package you select, you may still use our picnic area and Mulch Mountain.

Visits are scheduled for weekdays during October. All three of the above options require reservations.
